The candidates who are appearing/appeared in class 12 are eligible NEET 2020, provided they fulfill rest of the eligibility criteria. NEET 2020

NEET 2020 is the only medical entrance exam in India, other than AIIMS MBBS and JIPMER. It is only held in pen and paper mode and is of 720 marks. There are 180 questions from physics, chemistry, biology, and botany in the exam. The top scorers in the NEET are selected for the 15% All India Quota Seats allotments.

How much marks you need in NEET 2020 to be eligible for 15% All India Quota Seats Admission

The candidates must need a certain percentage of marks to be eligible for the All India based seat allotment. The candidates who do not score this minimum marks are, however, eligible for the state seat allotments. check the table below for the minimum marks you need to score to be eligible for All India Quota Counselling:

*Note that the cutoff percentile remains the same each year, however, the cutoff scores vary.

NEET 2020 Age Limit: The age limit in NEET is one of the most talked-about section of the exam. Few things that aspirants of NEET 2020 should know are as follows:

Background Story

- Last year, on page 10 of the information brochure NTA mentioned that there is lower and upper age limit in NEET and candidates above 25 years of age were not allowed to apply.
- However, the matter was taken to Supreme Court and just before the end of registration deadline SC issued interim order on the upper age limit. This meant that the candidates above 25 years, fulfilling rest of the eligibility criteria, could apply for the exam and the court is looking into the matter and the final verdict will be announced later now. Will There be Age Limit for NEET 2020

- The matter is still in the court and final verdict regarding the same has not been taken yet.
- So will there is an age limit or not, will only be disclosed when the new information for NEET 2020 will be released.

Nationality: All the Indian nationals and Overseas Citizens of India are eligible to apply for NEET 2020.



Educational Qualification: Candidates can check below the minimum qualification needed to apply for NEET 2020 –

- The students should have passed Class 12th or its equivalent examination, from a recognized board.
- The candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology at the qualifying examination.
- The students who have taken biology as an additional subject in 10+2, can also apply for NEET 2020.

Minimum qualifying marks to appear for NEET 2020: UR – 50%, OBC/SC/ST – 40%, PWD – 45% (minimum aggregate marks only for PCB subjects).

NEET 2020 Application Form

To appear for NEET 2020 the candidates have to fill the online application form, by following a certain process. The candidates can check the mode of [applying for NEET 2020](#) and how to apply for it in the steps below:

- Candidates have to register first using their basics details.
- Thereafter they are provided their NEET 2020 application number that they have to keep safe until the end of the admission process.
- Using the application number and the password the candidates have to log in and fill the application form.
- Next, the candidates have to fill the application form.
- Then the candidates have to upload the needed scanned documents.
- Lastly, to submit the application form the candidates have to make the payment
- On successful payment, the candidates have to print the confirmation page as proof as to their application form being complete.

Mode of payment of NEET 2020 Application Fee: Candidates could pay the application fee via Net Banking/Debit Card/Credit Card/E-Challan/UPI

NEET 2020 Application Form Correction

Once the candidates have submitted the application form by paying the application fee, they get one last chance to make any correction in the details they have submitted. However, the corrections are allowed in the limited field only like:

- Father's name
- Mother's name
- Date of Birth
- Gender
- Category

No changes are allowed in these fields:

NEET 2020 Admit Card

The candidates can download their **NEET Admit Card** from their login at ntaneet.nic.in. Candidates are not given their admit card via any other mode like via post or courier. The candidates have to download the admit card and follow the instruction on it on the day of the exam. The candidates have to carry the printed copy of the NEET 2020 admit card at the exam centers.

NTA also mails the PDF file of the admit card to the registered email ids of the candidates. In the admit card the candidates can also check their NEET 2020 Roll Number, Name, Father's Name, Category, Sub-Category, Photograph, Signature, Date of Birth, Language of Question Paper with Name and Address of Examination Centre allotted.

NEET 2020 Response Sheet and Question Paper

The candidates can check the NEET 2020 response sheet and the question papers under their NEET 2020 candidate login. The response sheet of the candidates has all the responses that the candidates have marked on the day of the exam. The candidates can use the response sheet to cross-check their answers from the **NEET Answer Key** and get the number of correct and wrong answers that they have attempted in the NEET 2020 exam.

NEET 2020 Answer Key

The candidates can check the answer keys of NEET 2020 exam on the official website under their login. The NEET 2020 answer key has all the correct answers to the questions asked in the exam. The candidates can crosscheck the answers that they have marked in the exam using the answer key and get the raw marks in NEET 2020.

The candidates have to use the marking scheme of the exam to calculate their raw score. The formula to calculate the NEET 2020 raw score is:

NEET 2020 raw score: 4 X (no. of correct answers) – 1 X (no. of wrong answers)

Candidates can challenge the NEET 2020 Answerkey. If the challenges are accepted the amendments are made in the answer key a final answer key is released. based on the final answer keys the NEET 2020 result is calculated.

NEET 2020 Result

The candidates can check the NEET 2020 Result in the form a scorecard inside their login and in a form of the merit list for the counselling of 15% All India Quota.

NEET 2020 Scorecard

The candidates can check their raw scores and the percentile score in the exam for each section separately and for overall in their NEET 2020 exam. The result also has the category wise cutoff marks and percentile score of the exam for 15% All India Quota. The candidates can also check their **NEET 2020 All India Rank (AIR)** in the scorecard.

The percentile score in NEET 2020 is calculated using the formula:

$$100 \times \frac{\text{Number of candidates appeared with raw score EQUAL TO OR LESS than the candidate}}{\text{Total number of the candidates appeared}}$$

NEET 2020 Merit List

In the NEET 2020 merit list, the names of the candidates are included who secure the minimum qualifying marks in the exam. That is the candidates who surpass the NEET 2020 cutoff marks get a place in the NEET 2020 Merit List.

NEET 2020 Counselling

The counselling of NEET 2020 is held for the 15% All India quota and the rest is for the state quotas. The all India counselling is done by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC). NTS is not responsible for the counselling. They prepare the AIR and send it to the MCC.

The counselling is held online, and to participate in it the candidates first have to register and submit the choices for the course and colleges. Then, as per the rank of the candidates, MCC issues seat allotment result. Selected candidates have to appear for document verification and then final admission is done.

The candidates have to carry the important documents in original and a set of the xeroxed copies at the counselling documents verification rounds. The important documents are:

- NEET 2020 Admit card
- NEET 2020 scorecard
- Rank Letter by MCC
- Birth Certificate
- Class X Certificate
- Class XII Certificate and marksheet

NEET 2020 Reservation Policy

The candidates can check below the reservation policy that is followed for the 155 All India Quota seat allotments:

- 15% of seats are reserved for SC candidates.
- 7.5% of seats are reserved for ST candidates.
- 27% for reserved for OBC candidates.
- For **EWS is subjected to norms of Ministry.**

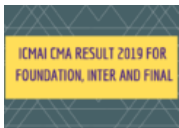
